The purpose of the roadmap meeting is to provide stakeholders and interested parties with a status report on progress to date, to map and discuss the path forward for Phase I demonstrations, and to examine the roles of the participants in the next phases of the project. The overall purpose of the project is to demonstrate the value of regional dynamic information systems in the eastern interconnection and to enable the use of these new sources of information by providing tools and training to industry stakeholders. A dynamic information system is characterized by high speed, high bandwidth and accurately time-tagged data.

DOE and the Consortium for Electric Reliability Technology Solutions (CERTS) have received positive feedback on this project from prominent members of industry including representatives from ISO-NE, MISO, NYISO, PJM, TVA and various transmission owners. Furthermore, work to analyze the Aug 14 blackout points to the value of a networked, wide area measurement system that includes time-synchronized archived data to aid the investigation. By participating in this meeting, attendees will have the opportunity to help shape the future of these information networks.
